Elementary school

We warmly invite parents, nursery teachers, as well as teachers from nursery schools, kindergartens, elementary, junior high, and high schools, and anyone else involved, to engage in discussions about any concerns or worries they may have. Together, we will explore effective strategies and solutions to address these challenges.

## Medical care



To ensure the well-being of schoolchildren requiring daily medical assistance such as phlegm suction, tube feeding, urethral catheterization, and other necessary care, we have dedicated nurses assigned to their needs, to help schoolchildren enjoy school life.

## Map and Access Guide



[By train]

- Our location is conveniently situated just a 10-minute walk from Sumiyoshicho Station of the Meitetsu Kowa Line.

[By car]

- If you are traveling by car, it will take approximately 10 minutes from the Handa Chuo Interchange on the Chitahanto Road. After exiting the interchange, turn right and head east. At the Yanabenishimachi intersection, make a right turn, then proceed eastward. At the Hiragicho 3 East intersection, make a left turn and continue traveling east. Finally, turn left again at the Handa High School South intersection and head north.
- Alternatively, if you are coming from National Road No. 264 and Prefectural Road No. 247, travel west at the Deguchicho intersection. Then, make a right turn and head north at the Handa High School South intersection.
